"Shoestring Revue" and "Shoestring '57" are actually recordings from two different shows. If your budget permits you to purchase only one, then I'd say that "Shoestring Revue" is a must-have. You get to hear Bea do two solos: the infamous "Garbage" as well as a wonderful monologue called "Couldn't Be Happier." She's also part of a singing trio that does a number that seems quite ironic in view of her subsequent animal-rights activities; it's called "Mink, Mink, Mink." In addition, there are several songs that feature the entire company. Of those, the biggest Bea revelation is "Medea in Disneyland," which she does in accent. If her name hadn't been listed in the credits for that song, I doubt that I would have realized it was her singing. (The only time I've ever heard her sound like that is on the "Golden Girls" episode in which Blanche's grandmother's house is about to be torn down.) Bea doesn't have any solos on "Shoestring '57." However, she is part of a trio ("The Arts"). Painted Smiles also has a recording called "New Faces of 1956." I've never seen or heard it -- only seen it listed in an online library catalogue. But Bea supposedly sings a song from "A Mother's Kisses." Years later, after her success with "Mame," she was slated to star in "A Mother's Kisses." Sadly, the show folded before it got to NYC. If it hadn't, that would have been Bea's first starring role on Broadway.
