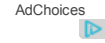

"The US star delivered a giant card to the Thai consulate in Sydney, Australia, where she is performing.

"The campaign is run by People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals, who are protesting against the training of elephants to be used as tourist attractions.

"The whole idea of preparing elephants for circuses and rides, it's so dumb, it's just idiotic," Arthur said."
