However, on Wednesday evening, when she mentioned having gone to drama school in 1947, someone in the audience responded to that. (I can't remember what he did -- he probably just "oohed" or did something to indicate what a long time ago that was.) She did say two or three words in response -- which she hadn't done the night before. Also, I don't remember hearing her Tallulah impersonation the second night. In other words, I just don't see this woman doing a pre-recorded show. She is just too professional for that, and I really believe that she is doing this show, in part, to challenge herself.
